We are hopeful that we will be offering dances later this year and remain attentive to guidelines established by the State of Louisiana and the City of Baton Rouge. Guidelines posted at Visit Baton Rouge (<https://www.visitbatonrouge.com/tools-info/coronavirus-information/>) as of 5/15/21 include two that are of particular interest to us. Those are: 1) *Live music will require 10 feet of space between the stage and the audience. Crowds must be seated.* 2) *Events held indoors will be limited to 75% capacity, while maintaining social distancing, or at 100% capacity with masking required and enforced.*
